



Elizabeth Melendez Fisher Good became a leader in the anti-sex trafficking movement by co-founding a domestic service provider in 2011. She has been instrumental in providing freedom to nearly 10,000 survivors. Out of this passion to end exploitation and protect children, another dream was born. The Foundation United (est. 2018), collaboratively brings together leading organizations to provide systemic change and scale best practices to eradicate sexual exploitation and address the root of sexual abuse. Their initiatives include *Prevention* (in schools through *SPEAK UP*, and in faith communities through *REAL TALK*),

Protection (training frontline responders in healthcare and criminal justice), *Awareness* (public education) and *Provision* (supporting select aftercare models until sex trafficking has been eradicated).
